Announces Grant of CHF 40'000.- for Young Independent Investigator

Plan and Research Focus

The SGED/SSED will accept applications within any area of basic or clinical endocrinology and diabetes research. The main purpose of this grant is to encourage young investigators (less than 40) to develop an independent line of research. All applications will be considered on an equal basis and judged on their intrinsic scientific merit.

Funding

Research will be supported through the award of a grant up to CHF 40'000.

The upper age limit is usually 40 years. Older candidates may be considered, in the event of special medical and/or other factors that justify making an exception.

The principal investigator must be a member of the SGED/SSED.

The principal investigator (and co-investigators) must be normally employed in Switzerland at a non-profit institution and the study must be performed at such a place of work. The applications will be reviewed by the Research Commission of the SGED/SSED.

All applications must be prepared on the official forms and completed in accordance with the instructions. Application forms may be downloaded from: www.sgedssed.ch/

Reporting requirements

At the end of the funding period, but not later than two years after funding, all investigators funded by SGED/SSED are required to present their work at the Annual Assembly and to submit a short scientific report. Investigators must acknowledge the support of the SGED/SSED in official publications (papers, activity reports, etc...).
