Invitation to submit your scientific contributions Annual Meeting of the Swiss Society of Endocrinology and Diabetology

November 16 and 17, 2023 BernExpo, Berne

Dear Colleagues,

We are delighted to invite you to submit your scientific contributions to the Annual Meeting of the Swiss Society of Endocrinology and Diabetology (SSED) and are looking forward to welcoming you.

This year's meeting will for the first time take place at the BernExpo in Berne. The structure of the meeting is similar to 2022. The meeting of the ASEMO (Swiss Association for the Study of Metabolism and Obesity) will take place on Thursday November 16, 2023, in the morning with lectures and oral presentations. The SSED program starts on Thursday afternoon with a plenary lecture followed by a symposium and a pro-and-con debate. The Swiss Obesity meeting will be held in parallel to this afternoon session. The program will conclude with our business meeting followed by the official dinner.

On Friday November 17, 2023, the program will feature two plenary lectures, oral abstract presentations, clinical updates, poster presentations and lectures supported by our sponsors.

The following prizes will be awarded: «Awards for the best oral presentation» (clinical and basic-experimental), «Awards for the best poster» (clinical and basic-experimental), and the «Award for the best student presentation» (oral or poster).

Abstracts can be submitted in two categories:

«Basic-experimental»:

Communications from *in vitro* studies and investigations in animal models.

«Clinical»:

Communications from studies with patients including epidemiological data



Abstracts must be submitted in English according to the pre-formatted attachment:

- Title of the study
- Authors
- Institution
- Address of the institution
- Background, methods, results, conclusion (no figures or references)
- Self-declaration of the category (basic-experimental, clinical; changes of categories possible after evaluation)
- Self-declaration for a possible oral contribution in the ASEMO meeting
- Status of the first author (student yes/no)

Oral presentations will be in English: 10 minutes presentation, 5 minutes discussion.

Please note the deadline of submission for abstracts: Monday, July 31, 2023 via e-mail to: abstracts@sgedssed.ch

The submission of the abstracts will be confirmed within a week.

Abstracts are acceptable for submission only if the corresponding work has not been accepted for publication before the submission deadline (July 31, 2023).

We are looking forward to receiving your contributions and are looking forward to seeing you in Berne.
